WHAT I.D. DO I NEED TO VOTE?

A valid *ID* must display the voter's name, photo, have an expiration date that did not expire before November 8, 2016, and be issued by the State of Indiana or the Federal Government. Valid IDs include:

- Indiana driver's license or Indiana photo ID card
- Military ID or VA ID
- **US** Passport
- A student ID from an Indiana State school if it meets all of the requirements

WHAT IF I'M A COLLEGE STUDENT?

College students may register and vote at either the address where they live while attending school, or the address where they live while not attending school. You must vote at the address where you are registered! Be sure to verify your registration prior to voting.
